Dear All,

Pursuant to the Regulation of the Minister of Health of 16 October 2020 on the temporary limitation of the activities of medical universities in relation to preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19 (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1833), the Regulation of the Minister of Education and Science amending the Regulation on the standards of education preparing for the profession of a doctor, dentist, pharmacist, nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist and paramedic (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1881) and in accordance with the Ordinance No. 241/XVI R/2020 of the Rector of Wrocław Medical University dated 6 November 2020 on the rules concerning the organisation of classes from 9 November 2020 throughout of the duration of the red zone in the country, I would like to inform you that there is a possibility of completing part of classes or groups of classes for students who performed activities within the framework of tasks carried out by medical entities or sanitary and epidemiological services in connection with SARS-CoV-2 as part of voluntary works coordinated by the University.

For students who conduct activities shaping practical skills (including as part of practical classes and traineeships) for which the study curriculum provides no learning outcomes covering practical skills acquired during the above-mentioned activities, within the framework of the volunteer works coordinated by the University, the Dean of the relevant faculty will recognise certain outcomes

(in terms of skills) in accordance with the procedure published at the website of Wroclaw Medical University in the

"VOLUNTEERING" tab. Absence from on-line classes will be excused by the academic teachers, but the unrealised outcomes (in terms of knowledge and competence) must be made up for by the student and completed in the manner indicated by the teacher. This process will be monitored by the Dean of the relevant faculty in order to maintain the quality of education and secure the future recognition of diplomas. Students conducting volunteer work outside the formula developed by the University are required to participate in all classes conducted in real life conditions or online.

The voluntary activity of the students of Wroclaw Medical University during the SARS-CoV-2 epidemic is extremely desirable and commendable. In these difficult times for all of us, any such initiative must be appreciated. Bearing in mind the very difficult sanitary and epidemiological situation all over the country, we encourage our students to volunteer and our academic teachers to understand and support these initiatives. I hope that the presented regulations will be well received by the entire academic community of our University, academic teachers, students and administrative staff. I also hope that you will treat these recommendations as a concern for the quality of education and responsibility for the practical competences of graduates of Wroclaw Medical University.

Once again, on behalf of the Rector and Dean College, I would like to emphasise our appreciation for the effort that all of you put in performing your professional and educational duties in these difficult times, as well as for the commitment of our students to helping patients.
